Title : Family Support and Family Well-Being of Member's Muhammadiyah in Surabaya

Abstrac

: Covid-19 has resulted in disruption of food security, economic, and stress, as well as a decline in family well-being. Including how families do work from home optimally while caring for and educating children at home, and preventing disease transmission and about increasing mental health problems. The aim of this study was to analyse the relationship between family support and family wellbeing of member's Muhammadiyah in Surabaya during the pandemic period. The research used a cross-sectional design. The number of samples is 289 Muhammadiyah families with the sampling technique using Stratified Multistage Random Sampling. Researchers distributed questionnaires by visiting family homes. During the pandemic the family support of member's Muhammadiyah showed that as many as 145 (50.2%) respondents said they were good while 144 (49.8%) were sufficient. Meanwhile, Family Well-Being as a whole resulted in 223 (77.2%) respondents being categorized as high, and as many as 66 (22.8%) respondents being categorized as moderate. Based on the non-parametric SPSS analysis test, it showed that there was a significant relationship between family support and Family Well-being with a p value of < 0.001.
